

⁷and he said with a loud voice, 'Fear God, and give Him glory, because the hour of His judgment has come; **worship Him who made the heaven and the earth and sea and springs of waters.**'"

Worshipping God

- We cannot worship someone we don't know
- Faith: illustration



"It is the darkness of misapprehension of God that is enshrouding the world. **Men are losing their knowledge of His character.** It has been **misunderstood** and **misinterpreted**. At this time a message from God is to be proclaimed, a message illuminating in its influence and saving in its power. His character is to be made known. Into the darkness of the world is to be shed the light of His glory, the light of His goodness, mercy, and truth... **The last rays of merciful light, the last message of mercy to be given to the world, is a revelation of His character of love.** The children of God are to manifest His glory. In their own life and character they are to reveal what the grace of God has done for them. The light of the Sun of Righteousness is to shine forth in good works—in words of truth and deeds of holiness." {Christ's Object Lessons, p. 415}

- How can a judgment be a good news?

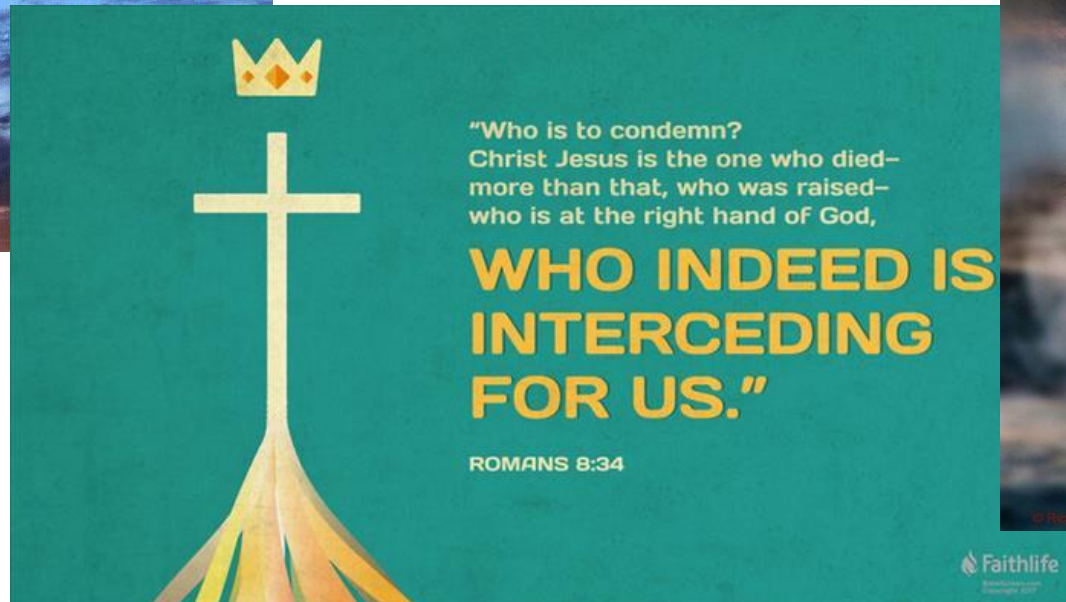
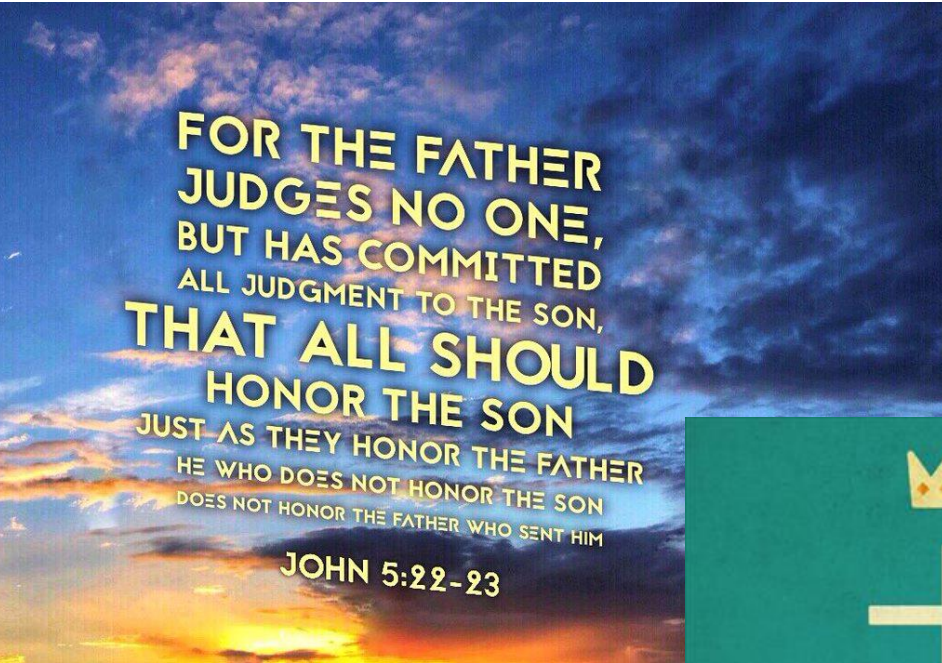


Jesus is our Judge and Advocate

Zec 3:1 And he shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and Satan standing at his right hand to resist him.

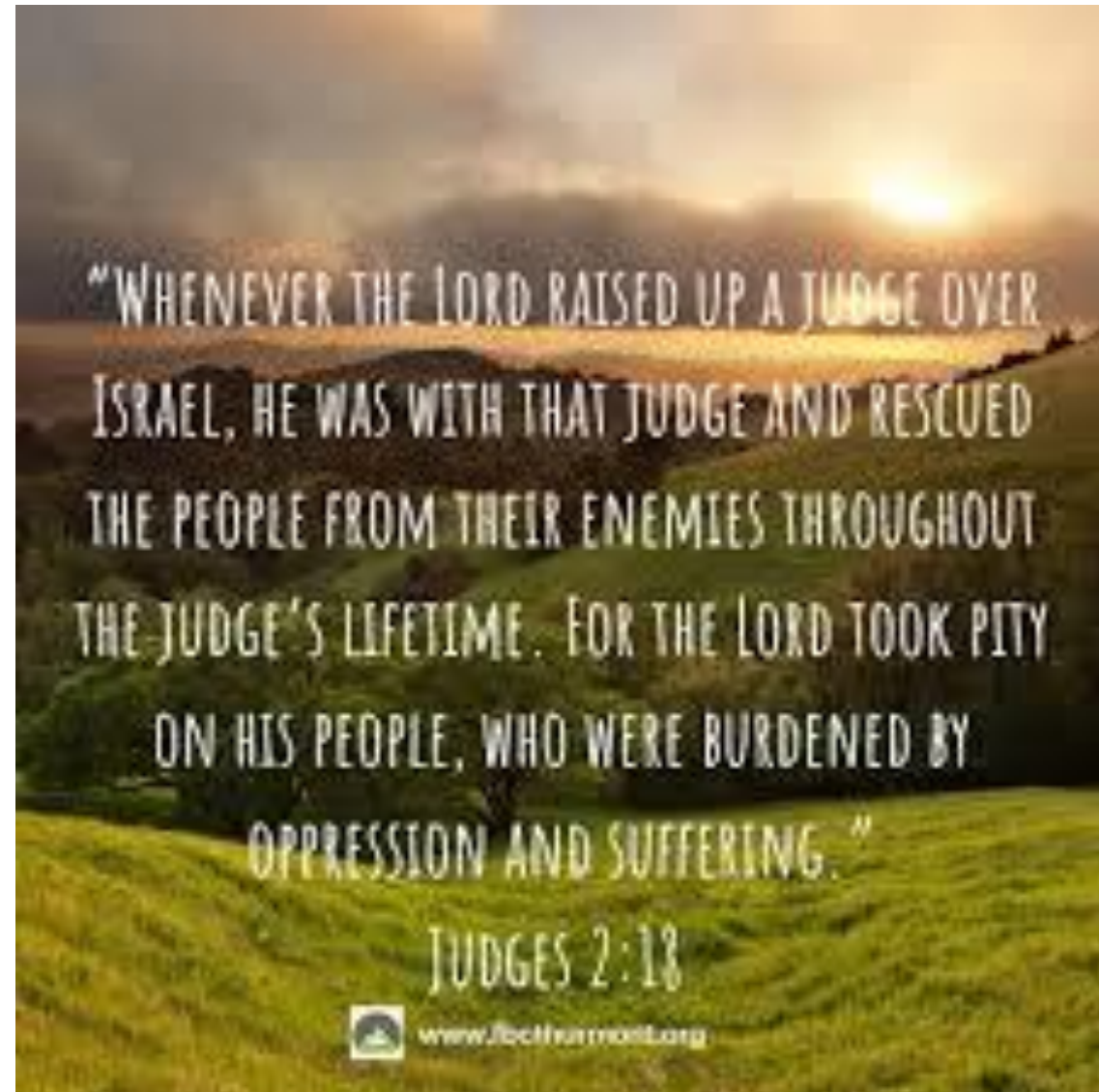
Zec 3:2 And the LORD said unto Satan, The LORD rebuke thee, O Satan; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: *is* not this a brand plucked out of the fire?

Zec 3:3 Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel.

Zec 3:4 And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.

Zec 3:5 And I said, Let them set a fair mitre upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the LORD stood by.







Sanctuary, Judgment and Bloating of the sins

- Sacrifice for sins: sins transferred to sanctuary
- Day of Atonement: Bloating of the sins from the sanctuary (Lv 16.29-34)
